How it Works

The Ministry Collaborative brings together a committed cohort of approximately

10-15 clergy from the same community for a period of three years to develop strategies for leading dynamic and effective ministries. Under the leadership of a trained facilitator, cohort groups engage in a spiritual journey of enrichment and rejuvenation that will have a positive and lasting impact.

Here are the Six Pillars of The Ministry Collaborative Cohort Experience:

Committed Cohorts

The cohort is a highly committed, supportive learning community of 10-15 ministry leaders from your community that meets approximately 10 months per year for three years.

Trained Facilitators

Facilitators lead cohort development, serving as a pastor to the pastors throughout their journey.

Contextualized Peer Learning

Facilitators and cohorts engage in a highly contextualized processoriented curriculum.

Community Engaged Congregations

Engaging lay leaders is essential for healthy congregations and flourishing communities.

Access to Leading Voices

A variety of gifted leaders from across the country engage with cohorts to generate creative ideas, insights, and imagination.

Formative Immersion Experiences

Sustained learning takes place through hands-on, one to two weeklong experiences in alternate contexts where bonds are deepened, and imaginations are stirred.
